We have replaced the hawthorn hedge at the cemetery which was diseased. Thank you to Stuart Goostrey, and Steve and Martin Robertson for carrying out this work. The drainage issue at the cemetery is still ongoing and we await further developments. Finally on behalf of us all we wish Sophie and Piers all the best for their forthcoming new addition to the family.				
3	Finance Report for year ended 31 March 2021. The Clerk & RFO had tabled the summary of Receipts & Payments Account for the financial year ended 31 March 2021 showing balances of £3679.21 in the current account and £2034.92 in the reserve account as at 31 st March 2021. She reported that the precept for 2021-22 had been set at £4864 (£21 less than 2020/21). Additional income was received from fees for interments and memorials and a VAR reclaim. Our expenditure included the usual annual costs of staffing, cemetery maintenance, water bills, payroll, website hosting costs and insurance. There were no room hire costs due to using zoom for meetings. The internal audit has been concluded satisfactorily and the Parish Council will be submitting the Annual Governance and Accountability Return after the Annual Meeting
