4	Finance Report for year ended 31 March 2020. The Clerk & RFO had tabled the summary of Receipts & Payments Account for the financial year ended 31 March 2020 showing balances of £3378.29 in the current account and £2034.07 in the reserve account as at 31 st March 2020. She reported that the precept for 2020-21 had been increased to £4885. The balance carried forward in the current account have increased from 2019 due to income from fees for interments and memorials. Our expenditure included the usual annual costs of staffing, cemetery maintenance, water bills, payroll, room hire, website hosting costs and insurance. The internal audit has been concluded satisfactorily and the Parish Council will be submitting the Annual Governance and Accountability Return after the Annual Meeting Questions and discussion on matters affecting the Parish: As there were no residents of the Parish in attendance no further discussion took place
